Kathy Graf; Has been an antique dealer for 15 years and previously owned a shop in Waukesha. Currently is in two shops in Waukesha and Milwaukee. Has a broad area of expertise and general knowledge of various items from ephemera (paper) to furniture.

Juanita Gorden; Has been a dealer for 11 ½ years and is currently in two shops. Area of expertise is American kitchen ware from the 30's, 40's and 50's.

Destin (Dusty) Lunde; Has been a dealer for over 45 years and is an expert in architectural restoration. Recently opened Plaza Architectural Antiques in Waukesha and previously operated a shop in the Lake Geneva area for more than 20 years. Specializes in mansion quality architectural remnants. Has a general knowledge of all types of antiques.

Dan Fairbanks; Has been a dealer for 6 years, currently in one mall. Has a general knowledge of all antiques including furniture. Specialty is Head Vases.
